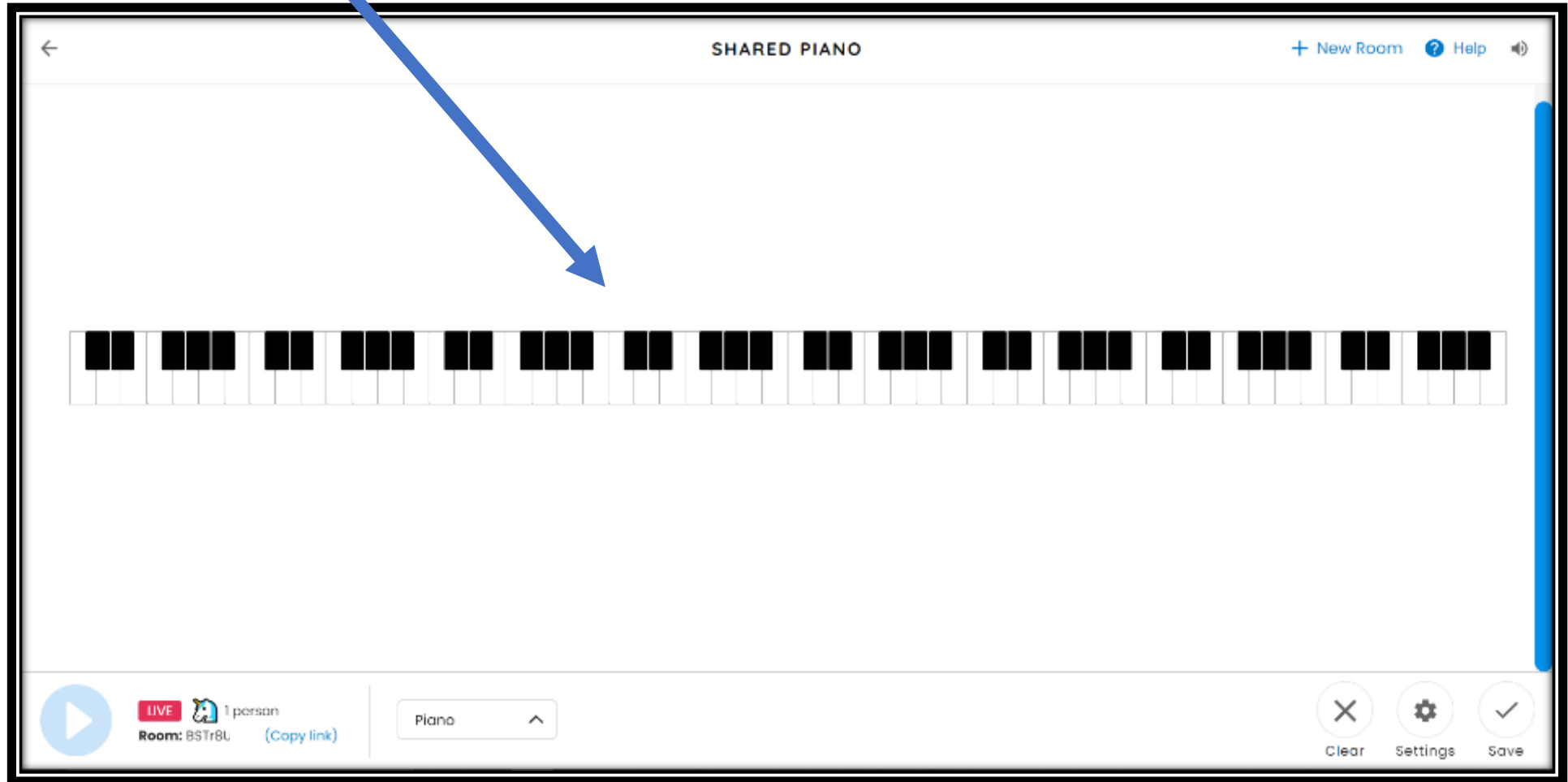


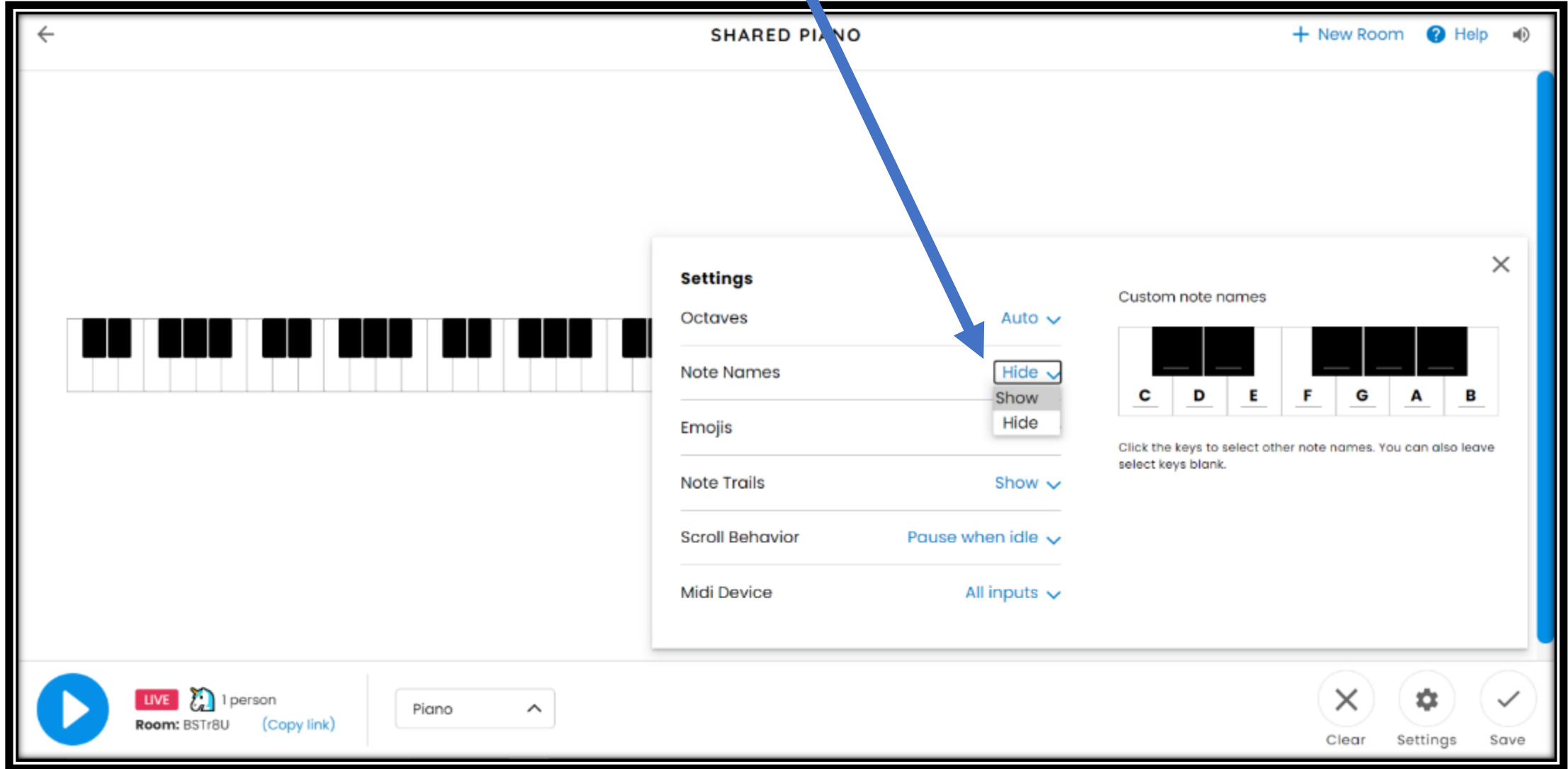
Google 'Music Lab Shared Piano' and select this (usually the first hit):

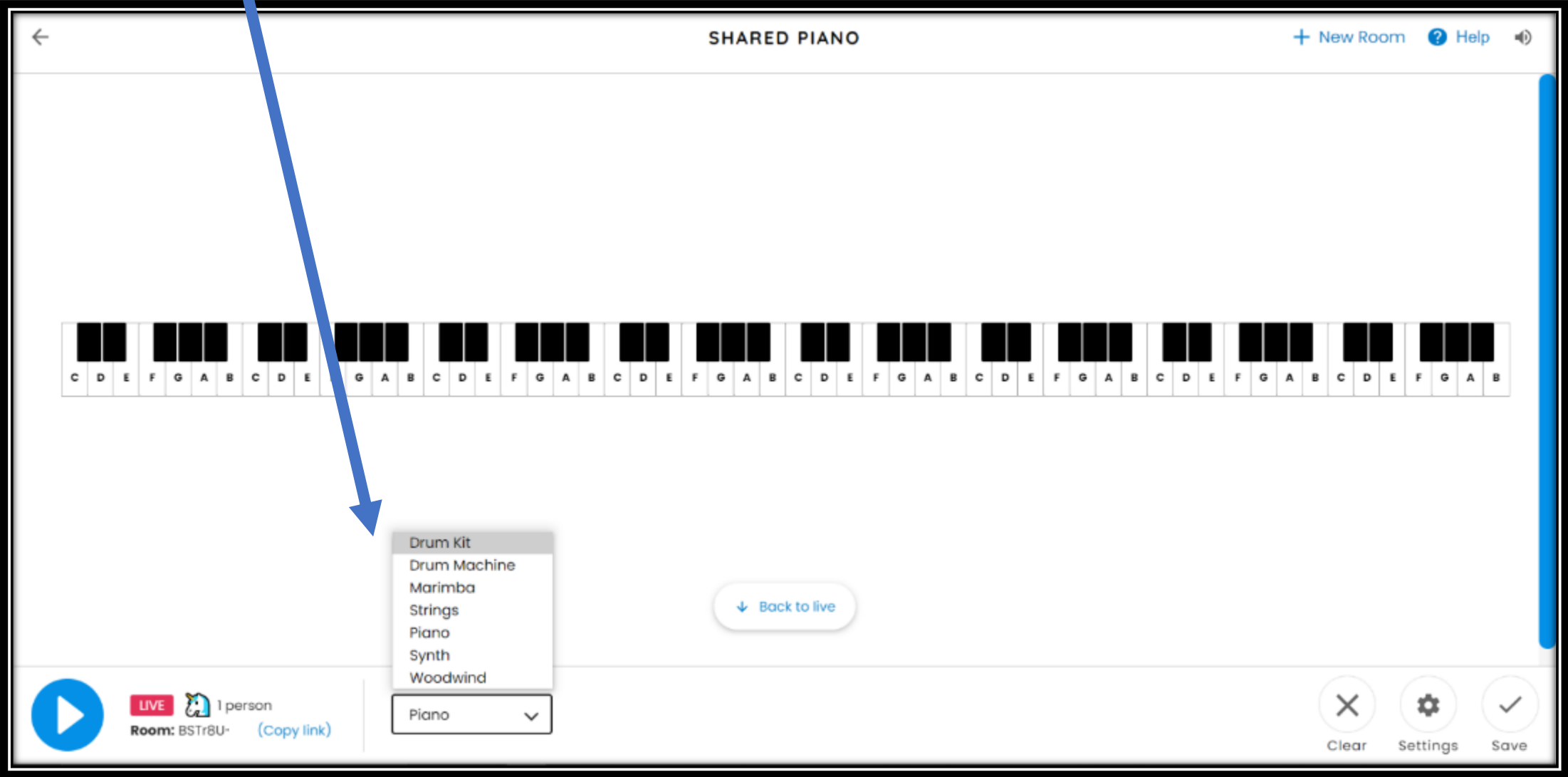
It is a virtual piano that you can use for practical applications using your mouse, track pad, qwerty keyboard, touch screen device (such as a phone, tablet or laptop) as well as having a music keyboard plugged into your computer.



If you prefer to have the names of the notes on the keyboard you can enable this function by selecting 'Settings' and selecting 'Show'. Remember to only use this if you really need to.



To change the sound from piano you can choose from 7 different instruments by selecting the drop down menu where it says 'Piano'...



To share your piano with another person or group all you need to do is copy the link highlighted and send it to them. The link is randomly generated every time you go to the website. Assuming you are able to speak with them over the phone or via message you can coordinate your ensemble playing.
