

The 16 to 19 Tuition Fund

Total funding for 2020-21: £2 797

What is the purpose of the fund?

In 2020-21, the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) has provided funding to support 16 to 19 students disadvantaged by disruption arising from COVID-19.

In line with the guidance we are using the funding to support tuition for students in English and maths. We are targeting the students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 in GCSE in English and/or maths.

This funding will support small group tuition by specialist teachers for maths (six students) and English (five students). All the students will be entered for the GCSE Autumn series and the summer 2021 exam if required.

How will we measure the impact of the fund?

The impact will be measured through analysis of the exam results.

We were pleased that in the 2020 Autumn series four students improved their grades in English and gave now gained at least a 4 with one student achieving a 5. In maths one student improved their grade to a four. The tuition will continue with a group of one in English and five in maths in preparation for the 2021 exams.

What is the purpose of the fund?

In 2021-22, the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) has provided funding to support 16 to 19 students disadvantaged by disruption arising from COVID-19.

In line with the guidance we are using the funding to support tuition for students in English, maths and other subjects. We are targeting the students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 in GCSE in English and/or maths. Alongside identified disadvantaged students who need extra support due to covid disruption.

This funding will support small group tuition by specialist teachers for maths, English and other identified academic subjects.

How will we measure the impact of the fund?

The impact will be measured through analysis of the exam results and other ongoing progress measures.

We were pleased that in the 2021 Autumn series four students improved their grades in English and maths.
