

What to expect...

- Your seating plan will be on the Year 11 Google classroom year page the day before.
- You will need to wear your **full school uniform**.
- You will be required to wait outside prior to your exam and you must enter the exam hall in <u>silence</u>. You must follow all exam expectations which we will go through later.
- If you have an exam you go straight to your exam room not your lesson.
- You will <u>**not**</u> be allowed off site at lunch from Monday 15th May.
- The whole school will be following the timings of the new school day.
- Attend your usual lessons if you do not have an exam and return to your usual lesson straight after an exam. This will be the arrangement until after May half term.
- For morning exams, if you travel on the bus and this is running late you must wait at the bus stop. If the bus breaks down or is stuck in traffic you must remain on the bus. Do not get off the bus, we will be notified of this and make arrangements.

Black pens – get something you like writing with! Have spares!



Summary - Student Expectations

- Wear full school uniform
- <u>Make sure you have the correct equipment for your exam.</u>
- Labels MUST be removed from water bottles. Your hands MUST have NO writing on them and your pockets should be empty.
- You must <u>be on time</u> for your exam. Get there <u>at least 15 minutes before</u> the exam starts. (Do NOT go to registration if you have a morning exam)
- You must **<u>enter the exam hall/gym in SILENCE</u>** and remain in silence until you leave.
- Sit in the seat indicated by the **<u>seating plan</u>**.
- PHONES must be switched off and in your bag. Watches, earphones and air pods must <u>not</u> be worn. These can <u>not</u> be in your pockets/on your person.
- You must not graffiti on your exam paper, this is to be used to provide your answers only. You are at risk of disqualification if you do.
- Go to the **toilet prior to the exam**.
- <u>Check that you have the correct paper</u> in front of you. We expect you to take responsibility in checking you have the RIGHT exam paper please put your hand up if this is not the case.

- Make sure you know when each exam is and where you need to be for it See Miss Brown the exams officer if you need a new timetable
- Stick to your revision plan
- Ask your teachers if you have any subject specific questions!
