Genuine enthusiasm came across in all he did, and this extended beyond the classroom as he recently accompanied Sixth Form students on a visit to Auschwitz.

Every member of staff who met or worked with Mr Annison commented on his real enthusiasm. He was a very popular colleague who found time to talk to a wide range of people across school. Teaching was clearly the right profession for him and our school was a better place with Mr Annison in it.

Mr Annison will be missed by everyone in our school but he leaves behind a legacy of real success.
