Dear Parent/Carer

Poynton High School – "Bridging the Gap" Residential Conway Centre, Anglesey Friday 14th – Saturday 15th June 2024

We are really pleased your child has accepted a place at Poynton High School for September 2024.

As part of our transition programme, 'Bridging the Gap', we would like to invite your child to join us on a residential trip to the Conway Centre on Anglesey. This will bring together all students with a confirmed place at Poynton High School from primary schools outside of our feeder primaries and is designed to mirror the residential that our feeder primaries take part in.

Feedback from students and parents following our previous trips over the last 10 years, have said that it was a fantastic trip and really benefitted all students in making new friends and getting to know Poynton High School staff before they start in September. Working with the Conway Centre on Anglesey we have managed to secure such an opportunity for your child and we hope they will find it an exciting and rewarding experience.

This event will take place from **Friday 14**th **until Saturday 15**th **June**. Students will need to meet at Poynton High School at 9:00am for a 9:30am departure and will have an estimated return of 5:00pm on the Saturday. The Conway Centre is an outdoor education centre run specifically for schools. During the day students will take part in a range of team building activities, curriculum sessions run by the teaching staff of Poynton High School and a canoeing session run by qualified instructors from the centre. We really hope this will help your child make some new friends and reduce any anxieties about the move to secondary school.

Although this visit is to a residential centre and is different to the classroom experience, we expect that students continue to observe the high standards of behaviour that they show every day in school. Students should take indoor and outdoor clothes, as well as suitable clothes for sports events. We have included with this letter a list of the sort of items that students should take with them for the period of time that they are there. They will sleep in dormitories of up to ten students for which bed linen is provided. Towels and other toiletries should be taken by the students. All waterproofs and safety equipment needed for the activities will be provided by the centre.

There is a small shop which offers sweets and drinks, although this should be a supplement and not the sole diet. We suggest £5 is a sensible amount to bring with them but this is not essential. As we are only there for two days, may we also suggest that the students do not endeavour to contact home. We have, at the bottom of this letter, included the centre number should you feel it necessary to ring but only in the case of an emergency. This call is directed into the office and they would have to find a member of staff to respond to the call. It is not for use in contacting students.

Please do not allow your child to bring mobile phones, smart watches, electronic games or any expensive equipment.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch with them on the Friday for lunchtime.

In order to give you and your child some more information about the residential we will be holding an **Information Evening on Thursday 16th May at 4:45pm in the School Library**. At this meeting you and your child will be able to meet some of the staff who will be going on the residential and we will be able to answer any further questions you may have. Please come to the main reception and you will be directed to the library.

We are asking parents to contribute £122 towards the cost of the trip. This includes return transport from Poynton High School, small group activities led by qualified instructors, accommodation, meals (excluding Friday lunch – packed lunch to be taken) and insurance.
