<p><b>Topics and skills to be revised and assessed:</b></p> <p>Assessment 1 – Macroeconomics. You will have a choice of questions, focussing on either supply side policies (Unit 4.2.5) or trade (Unit 4.2.6)</p> <p>Assessment 2 – Synoptic paper. Multiple choice questions focussing on the international economy (unit 4.2.6) and market failure (unit 4.1.8). 10 mark question focussing on economic performance and living standards (units 4.2.1.4 and 4.2.3)</p> <p>Assessment 3 – Synoptic paper. Focussing on the minimum &amp; living wage [units 4.1.6.6 and 4.1.7.3], economic performance and living standards (units 4.2.1.4 and 4.2.3)</p> <p>Assessment 4 – Microeconomics. You will have a choice of questions focussing on either public goods, private goods and quasi-public goods [4.1.8.3] and public ownership, privatisation, regulation and deregulation of markets [Unit 4.1.8.8] or market structures [Unit 4.1.5]</p> <p>Assessment 5 – Macroeconomics. You will have a choice of questions, focussing on either economic development (unit 4.2.6) or fiscal policy and the balance of payments (4.2.5.1 and 4.2.6.3)</p> <p>Assessment 6 – Microeconomics. You will have a choice of questions, focussing either on poverty and inequality [Unit 4.1.7] or the effect of government intervention [Unit 4.1.8.9] on positive and negative externalities in consumption and production [Unit 4.1.8.4].</p>

Question types ranging from 2 marks to 25 marks (1 hour)</p> <p>Assessment 2: MCQs &amp; 10 mark question linked to synoptic investigation (paper 3 style) (1 hour)</p> <p>Assessment 3: Synoptic 15 and 25 mark question, linked to context (paper 3 style) (1 hour)</p> <p>Assessment 4: Microeconomics essays (Section B of paper 1) – a choice of 2 essay sets. Question types: 15 &amp; 25 mark essay question (1 hour)</p>	

Assessment 5: Macroeconomics essays (section B of paper 2) – a choice of two essay sets. Question types: 15 & 25 mark essay question (1 hour).
