

High Expectations in Google Meet lessons.

For any live online lesson that is hosted by a member of staff, students will need to comply with the following rules and expectations or they will be removed from the lesson:

- Arrive promptly at the start of the live online lesson.
- Ensure that you are appropriately dressed and sitting upright – not lying on a sofa for example.
- Enter the lesson with your audio off. It is up to students if they wish to have cameras on or off.
- Remain engaged in the lesson, be polite to others and do not mess around with their video or audio settings.
- Do not share the meeting link with others outside of your class.
- Do not capture the screen or record the lesson.
- Only use the “Chat” function to ask a question if you need clarification on something that you do not understand. Inappropriate use of the “Chat” function will be sanctioned.
- Use your books and write down notes and complete tasks as appropriate. Effective presentation of work in exercise books remains important for your learning.
- Log into lessons using your school account not your personal Gmail account. You will be refused entry to the lesson if not on using school email account to log in.
- Work hard, get involved in the discussion and always try your best. House points will be awarded to students as they would in school.
