Heads of Department and Directors of Learning will <u>review the progress</u> of your child throughout the year.


Students may be invited to <u>intervention</u> <u>sessions</u> or provided with further support to ensure they progress.

### **GCSE Mathematics**

### **AQA** Higher Tier

- Designed for students aiming to study or have use of mathematics post 16
- Assesses grades 4 through to 9
- Grade 9 covers areas of maths currently taught at AS level
- 50% of questions are at grade 7-9



### **GCSE Mathematics**

#### **AQA Foundation Tier**

- Designed to assess all students in the basics of mathematics whilst stretching those students beyond the current grade C in Algebra, Geometry and Statistics
- Assesses grades 1 through to 5
- Grade 5 covers approximately  $\frac{2}{3}$  of the current grade B topics
- 50% of questions are at grade 4 & 5

- Paper 1 1 hour 45 minutes
  - assessing reading and writing
- Paper 2 1 hour 45 minutes
  - assessing reading and writing
