
Reformed GCSEs


- Year 9 will sit reformed GCSEs in all subjects
- 2017 saw the first results in Maths, English Language and English Literature
- Linear
- More challenging content
- Reduction in controlled assessment
- 9-1 grading the GCSE grading system will be used in reports and with key assessed work in Year 9
