**Important Message from our Sixth Form Team:**

I would like to clarify our position regarding admissions in to our Sixth Form and I would be grateful if you would share this with your young person.

If your son/daughter has applied for a place in our Sixth Form, please be reminded that they must achieve the minimum Sixth Form entry requirement for all students of 5 GCSEs at grades 9-4. Where students have followed a GCSE equivalent programme, four full course GCSE passes grade 4 or above must also be achieved. Our full list of entry requirements is contained in our prospectus which is on our website, [www.phs.cheshire.sch.uk/sixthform](http://www.phs.cheshire.sch.uk/sixthform)

Our decisions on eligibility for courses will be decided based on the grades your son/daughter receives on Thursday. Their results sheet will reflect the combination of their best grades from the Centre Assessed Grades (those submitted by us) and the Awarded Grades (the grades returned to us from the exam boards having been subjected to their moderation).

Instructions for the action required on receipt of their results to confirm their place for September will be in their envelopes. Your timely attention to this matter would be greatly appreciated to ensure places for all students can be confirmed as quickly as possible. Please ensure that you only use the email addresses indicated on either their results sheets or the Entry to Sixth Form sheet as other email addresses may not be monitored at this time and could lead to your enquiry being missed.
